WHERE IT ALL STARTED

The Rt. Rev. James S. Johnston, first bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of West Texas, founded West Texas Military Academy in 1893 to form “character among the rising generation.” He had high ideals for the new school, declaring that “The best education on Earth is none too good for Texas.”

As first head of school, he chose the Rev. Allan L. Burluson, an experienced educator who believed that the school would be “a great moral agency for good, (giving) us better neighbors, better citizens.”



Bishop James S. Johnston (top), first leader of the independent Episcopal Diocese of West Texas, made education a priority during his 28-year tenure. Johnston also was the founder of what is now St. Philip's College.



The Rev. Allan L. Burluson, our school's first headmaster, was an alumnus of the Shattuck School (now Shattuck-St. Mary's) in Minnesota, then an all-boys military school similar to TMI for most of its first century.

LETTER FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

During the 2018-2019 school year, we were proud to celebrate TMI Episcopal's 125th anniversary. Our school began with a tradition of giving, and you are all a part of that tradition.

When our founder, Bishop James S. Johnston, took a leap of faith and raised enough money in four months to establish the school that became TMI, he did it with a gift of land and even the parlor furnishings for the first building.

The school and his vision for it were so successful that the school outgrew that first campus and made a move to Alamo Heights – again, on donated land.

When we needed even more space to bring that vision up to date and share it with more families, TMI moved to our present campus – again, with gifts of donated land. Here, with the help of all our supporters, we have built the school's first dedicated chapel building, new residence halls, updated athletic facilities and more.

At the same time, we have stayed true to the ideals of our founder. “Character is the only true wealth,” Bishop Johnston wrote, and I believe he would recognize and approve of TMI's Core Values: Wisdom, Integrity, Service, Excellence and Reverence. At the same time, we are a school

where students are challenged by academic rigor and cherished by a community that loves them and knows them by name. Together, we strive to form a community that models what it means to belong to each other (Romans 12:5) and to respect the dignity of every human being (Baptismal Covenant, Book of Common Prayer).

TMI exists and has survived into the 21st century because our community – parents, alumni, grandparents and other friends of the school – has always believed in its mission of educational excellence as well as the formation of servant leaders for the future.

You live out that belief by giving generously of your time, your talents and your treasure. Thank you for your faith in our school!

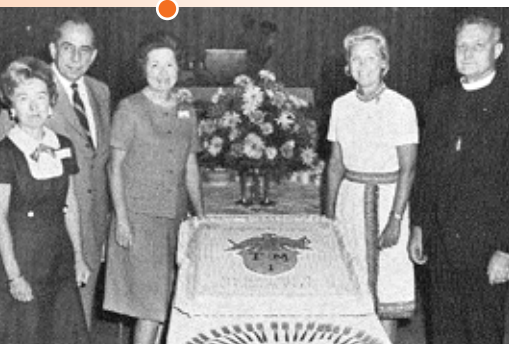

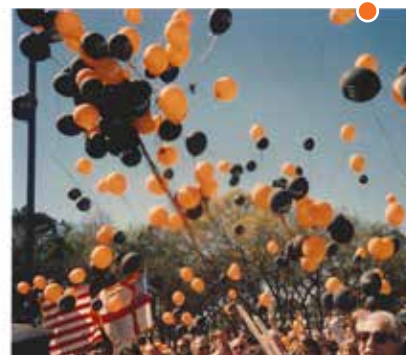

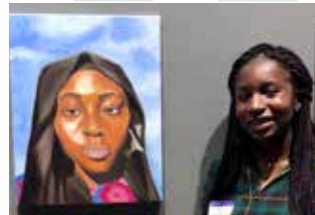

TMI celebrates 125th anniversary

Student OUTCOMES



The 73 members of the class of 2019 graduated May 23 in Oak Hills Church, a joyous occasion that capped the celebration of our 125th anniversary year. Graduates were set to attend a wide range of colleges and universities. TMI's newest alumni chose Texas schools including A&M, Baylor, Rice, Southern Methodist University, Trinity and the University of Texas at Austin. Outside the state, others were bound for Boston University, Cornell, Embrey-Riddle Aeronautical University, Georgia Tech, Notre Dame, Pepperdine, the University of Pennsylvania, the University of the South (Sewanee), University of Southern California and Vanderbilt.



In last year's National Scholastic Art Awards, TMI art students **Oluwatomike "Tomike" Falebita '19** (shown here at a regional exhibit) won a gold medal and two silver medals, and **Kelly Jung '19** (shown at her TMI senior exhibit) won a silver medal, all for their paintings. Both students previously had won Gold Key awards for their artwork in the San Antonio Scholastic Art Awards.



The TMI Episcopal **men's varsity soccer team** won the 2019 TAPPS Division II Boys Winter Soccer State championship game Feb. 22 at Waco ISD Stadium in Waco. The Panthers defeated Prince of Peace Christian School of Carrollton 3-2, following a 20-2-1 season in which they won their sixth consecutive district title and averaged more than four goals per game. Head Soccer Coach **Oscar Muñoz** was "especially proud of the way the team came together to support each other," and all starters are expected to return next season.

Cadet Battalion Commander **Hasan Ehsan '19** received the MacArthur Cadet Leadership Award, given by the General Douglas MacArthur Foundation to the top 40 outstanding cadets from schools that are members of the Association of Military Colleges and Schools of the United States. Recipients are recognized for emulating and practicing the leadership qualities MacArthur exemplified as a cadet at West Texas Military Academy (now TMI) and at the U.S. Military Academy (West Point). Ehsan, who also received the Founder's Award at graduation, will attend the University of Texas at Austin and plans to become a doctor.

All played leadership positions and earned multiple conference honors at TMI.



For the 25th year in a row, the **Texas Military Institute Corps of Cadets** has earned the title of Honor Unit with Distinction, the highest rating an Army JROTC unit can receive. This honor is the result of a JROTC Program for Accreditation (JPA) Inspection, conducted Feb. 4, 2019, by representatives of Cadet Command's 5th Brigade, headquartered at Fort Sam Houston. The Corps scored 98.6 percent, with eight individual cadets interviewed by the inspectors scoring 100 percent.



Delaney Martin '20 won the TAPPS 5A Womens Golf State Tournament, held April 30-May 1 in Glen Rose, scoring 68 and 69 for a total of 137. A member of the TMI **women's varsity golf team** that won its district championship, she was named to the San Antonio Express-News All-Area Super Team and committed to the University of Houston.



TMI students performed more than 16,000 hours of community service during the 2018-2019 school year, through our Interact club and other group and individual projects. During the summer, students participated in TMI mission trips to Dominica and Guatemala, served as camp counselors, worked on Scouting service projects, volunteered at Vacation Bible Schools, at animal shelters and in ministries for the needy.



The TMI Band earned the Superior Performance Award at the Texas Private School Music Educators Association competition, held April 5 in Houston. The band — led by **Rod Leonard**, a trombonist with the San Antonio Wind Symphony — performs at annual Christmas and spring concerts and is a favorite with the TMI community at school events such as Grandparents Day.

IN MEMORY



ROBERT MOSS AYRES, JR. (1926-2018),

TMI class of 1944, was a visionary leader in business, education and philanthropy. As an investment banker, he financed successful companies, including Southwest Airlines. On the board at TMI Episcopal, he advocated for coeducation and an optional military program – changes that ensured the school’s survival. As vice chancellor of the University of the South (Sewanee), he tripled the endowment and put the university on a sound financial footing for the future. Involved in the management of family ranches, Mr. Ayres became passionately interested in land conservation. With his wife Patricia Shield Ayres, he cofounded the Shield-Ayres Foundation, which focuses on solutions for basic human needs, such as the environment, education and health.

Robert M. Ayres, Jr. '44 and Tom C. Frost, Jr. '45 both were honored posthumously at the first Entrepreneur & Innovation Luncheon, Oct. 1, 2019.



TOM C. FROST, JR. (1927-2018),

TMI class of 1945, promoted transformational growth in San Antonio, South Texas and beyond. As head of one of the region’s largest banks, whose expansion he led, Mr. Frost played a role in major developments such as HemisFair '68, the South Texas Medical Center, the AT&T Center and the signing of the North American Free Trade Agreement. When TMI Episcopal moved to its present campus, he supported the move with the donation of the Frost Athletic Center and later strengthened the school’s mission as co-chair with Bishop James Folts of the capital campaign that built the school’s All Saints Chapel and two new dormitories. Throughout his life, Mr. Frost advocated for advances in education, cultural institutions, job creation, and international cooperation.

ALUMNA PLANS LASTING IMPACT

Courtney Wiley Caldwell '97 is the youngest-known member of TMI's 1893 Society for alumni and others who remember the school in their estate planning. A former director of digital marketing at Oracle, she is cofounder of ShearShare, a mobile app that connects salons and stylists, for which she won a 2017 L'Oreal Women in Digital award. Courtney is a member of the TMI Board of Trustees and of the Southern Methodist University Alumni Board. Recently, she shared her reasons for membership in the 1893 Society:



I had my first will done during the 2011-2012 school year, when I was in my early 30s. TMI and SMU are both in it because they are not just schools but ministries.

TMI was a big part of what has made me the woman I am. It was the best place to learn leadership because you are allowed to fail: If we did something incorrectly or didn't make the smartest choice, we would have to go back and do it again. The people of TMI loved us back to our roots in God's word and light.

While I was in my senior year at TMI, (as a staff officer in the Corps of Cadets), Sgt. Maj. (Turner) McGarity told me I could do whatever I wanted to do. In English, Mr. (Bob) Bell got me to write every day, and the thinking that was required in his class

constantly challenged me. Mr. (Mario) Rivela pulled the best out of all of us. And Mrs. (Jill) MacDougal, the college counselor, was pivotal in helping me to select a school. I had been planning to spread my wings, leave Texas and get as far away as possible, but she recommended going to SMU for their summer College Experience. That did it for me; after taking two courses there, it was SMU or bust.

High school or undergrad, I would go back and do it all again, the same way, at the same schools. TMI was so rich in goodness – Fiesta, Military Ball, pep rallies, community services – there’s a spirit I still feel when I walk back on campus, that “This is home.”

I’ve learned that the world has a lot of followers and not a lot of leaders. All you have to do is stand up and lead. The values that TMI has – integrity, caring for yourself and others – prepared me to lead a successful startup. For so many people, school is just a jumping-off place; for me, it was the start of the rest of my life.

PASSING THE BATON



For his 20 years of volunteer service, TMI thanks J. David Oppenheimer '67, former executive chair of the school's Board of Governors. Mr. Oppenheimer first was appointed to the board in 1999. Since then, he has served on several committees and became executive chair in 2017.

His most notable recent achievements on the board include his involvement in the transition of a new head of school, the Rev. Scott J. Brown, who was appointed in 2017; and the creation of a long-term strategic plan for the school.

Under Mr. Oppenheimer's leadership, the school has committed to build the Walker Innovation Center, a dedicated space for design thinking where students will explore and solve real-world problems, learn skills and apply knowledge across disciplines. The new building is expected to be completed for the 2020-2021 school year.

"Serving as executive chair capped many rewarding years

as a governor," Mr. Oppenheimer said, noting that the major gifts campaign for the Walker Innovation Center is "well on its way to success."

He will be succeeded as executive chair by Carol Holmes, who has served on the board since 2014 and has chaired the board's Advancement Committee.

Mrs. Holmes is a member of St. George Episcopal Church. She is also a former TMI parent, whose daughter Elizabeth, class of 2017, is a rising junior at Harvard College. "For more than 125 years, TMI has been committed to developing servant leaders," Mrs. Holmes said. "I'm humbled and honored to have the opportunity to contribute to that noble mission. Father Scott and David Oppenheimer have established a strong foundation and a compelling vision. I'm looking forward to bringing the many talents of the Board together as we create a community that prepares our students for an exciting future."

RESTRICTED GIFTS

Designated for specific purposes, such as scholarships or campus improvements.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

Gift of appreciated securities – publicly traded stocks, bonds and mutual fund shares – allow you to claim a charitable deduction for the full market value. You pay no capital gains tax on the appreciation. Contact the Advancement Office at TMI and your broker to initiate a stock transfer.

In honor of the school's founding year of 1893, donors who make a cumulative gift of **\$1,893** or more to TMI Episcopal during the fiscal year belong to the Founder's Circle and will receive an invitation to the annual donor recognition event that is held the following school year.

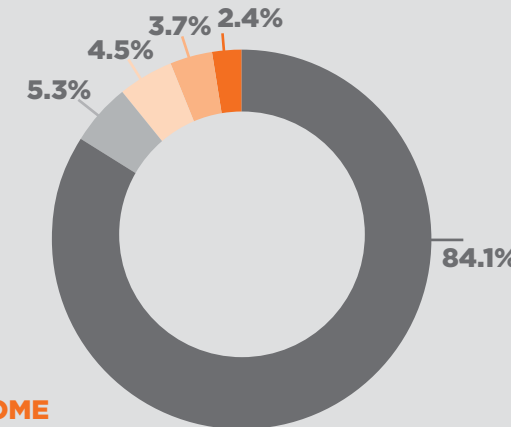

Annual giving supports the yearly operating budget for the school and bridges the gap between the true cost of delivering excellence in education at TMI and the cost of tuition.

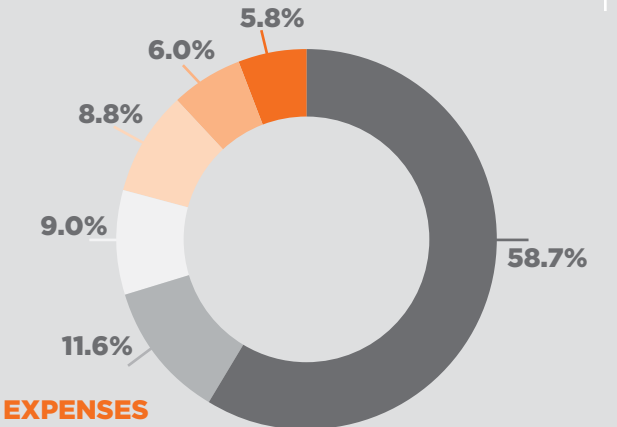

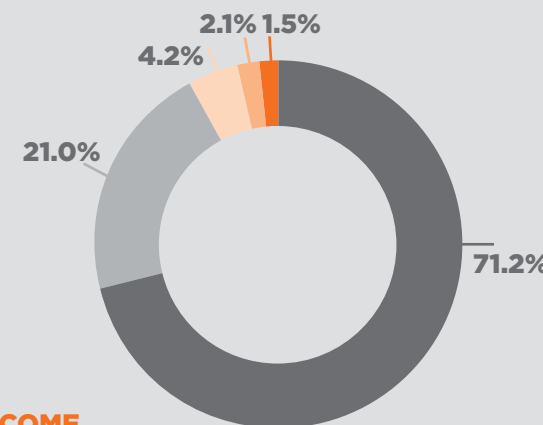

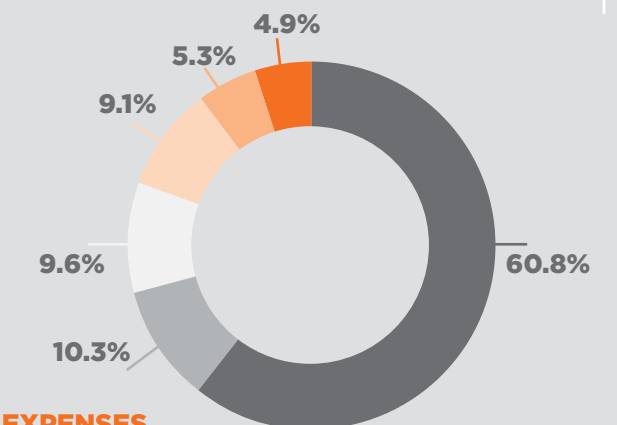
