LETTER FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL


Alex will continue part-time to serve TMI by working on special alumni projects to further advance the future and mission of TMI. She will continue her service until May 2023, when she will fully retire.





Donor Spotlight:

TMI Alumnus, Victor Beck '47



In May 2022, Victor Beck, class of 1947, celebrated the 75th anniversary of his graduation from TMI and we loved hearing about Victor's time and experiences as a student in the 1940s.





In his youth, Victor was a gifted student, which allowed him to skip two grades. He entered TMI as a ninth-grade boarding student at the age of only 12. Weighing about 90 lbs and standing at just 4 feet and 11 inches, he was not large enough in stature to compete athletically, but he excelled academically and had a deep dedication to the Corps of Cadets. Each morning, he began with a mile run, studied his courses, and carried out his orders. After ninth grade, he attended TMI as a day student and continued to develop habits of success, which was evident in him being a member of the National Honor Society and an officer in the Corps. As a 15-year-old senior, Victor had the unique experience of attending TMI with World War II veterans who returned from war and enrolled at TMI on the GI Bill. The discipline he learned in those formative years would become the foundation of his many accomplishments.

After Victor graduated from TMI at 16 years old, he attended college, majoring in business. He had also developed a love for baseball and his hours of pitching on a homemade mound at his parents' ranch paid off when he got to play in the minor leagues for a year with the opportunity to go pro — just like his hero, Ted Williams.

Ultimately, Victor joined the military after graduating from A&I Kingsville, now known as A&M Kingsville, and began his service to his country as an Army officer. He served in Korea as a post exchange officer, then returned home and began his own financial business.

Recently, Victor and his wife, Janis, spoke with TMI Episcopal about their decision to make a lasting impact on TMI with a legacy gift in their estate planning.

"I was inspired to make a provision in our estate plan that benefits

TMI because of the wonderful foundation the school has given to me. TMI prepared me for college and military service, and gave me the discipline and confidence to succeed in business," said Victor.

Today, Victor and Janis continue to be impressed with the education TMI provides and shared with us that they are moved by the amazing projects planned and produced in the Walker Innovation Center. "This legacy gift and our annual support of The TMI Fund is a way of thanking TMI for continuing its efforts of educating servant leaders," said Victor and Janis. They added, "We encourage others with an allegiance to TMI to do the same."

Victor and Janis, who have been married for 47 years, have a beautiful life with many things to be thankful for and proud of. Victor, an avid golfer, even made a hole-in-one on his 90th birthday!
