

Last school year was our largest enrollment in school history and we had incredible success, both academically and athletically. TMI received AP Honor Roll recognition from the College Board at the Platinum Level, and received the Access Award, putting us in the top 6% nationally of schools that offer AP courses. We are also proud to have had seven National Merit Commended Scholars and introduced a new Introduction to Business and Entrepreneurship course which will lay the groundwork towards a larger curriculum. The senior class of 2023 garnered \$13,093,870 in scholarship awards. This is the largest amount of scholarship offers in the history of TMI. Athletically, TMI earned four state championships and five regional/district championships in addition to many individual accomplishments across all sports. In fact, TMI garnered more athletic success than any other school in TAPPS 5A last year.

As we reflect on this past year, we want to recognize the many supporters of TMI. It is through the generosity of each of you that TMI is able to teach lifelong learning, build patient and kind human beings, and plant seeds that bear fruit both today, and for generations to come.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

SENIOR ACCEPTED INTO THE BEAT ACADEMY

Martha Toursarkissian '23 was accepted into the BEAT (Biomedical Excellence and Academic Training) Academy at UT Health Science Center San Antonio. This program exposes students to various research opportunities in the health sciences.

EXCELLENT SHOWING AT TEXAS GREAT DEBATE

Mara Flores '25 won first place in the Cross Examination category at National Hispanic Institute 2022 Texas Great Debate Competition, beating 25 other teams. Kevin Kessler '25 and Marco Anom Martinez '25 went on to compete in Athenaeum, also earning a first place finish.

BEST OVERALL AT RESEARCH ACADEMY

Anom Martinez '25 and his partner were awarded the Best Overall Award for their research and presentation at UIW's Gearhead Research Academy. The academy consisted of college level labs, focus groups and research developed exclusively for those with an interest in engineering, mathematics and/or science careers.

SENIOR DEVELOPS INNOVATIVE PROSTHETIC APPARATUS IN THE WALKER INNOVATION CENTER

Using the tools and systems he learned in his I&D class, Andrew Cubriel '23, modeled, designed, and developed a prosthetic apparatus for a patient with a partially missing finger. Andrew, who is also missing the end portion of his little finger, created a prosthetic that slips onto the underdeveloped digit and bends when curling the other knuckle of that same finger. To our knowledge, this is the first prosthetic that uses minimal resources and has potential to be a low-cost alternative to expensive pieces of medical equipment.

APPEARANCE AT TEXAS STATE ROBOTICS SEMIFINALS

TMI Robotics Team 6221 received the Design award for their robot and advanced to the Texas State semifinal competition.

INCREDIBLE YEAR FOR DEBATE TEAM SENIOR

Anish Beeram '23 was selected as a member of the USA National Debate Team. He was one of twelve students nationwide chosen to represent USA at national and international competitions. Selection for USA Debate was fiercely competitive and involved four rounds of elimination taking place over 3 months in which Anish advanced amongst hundreds of applicants to obtain this most prestigious position. This was the first time that a student from San Antonio has been chosen to represent the United States on the National Debate team, an honor that was highlighted in an interview with KSAT 12 News.

Competing against students from across Texas, Anish placed first in all of his rounds and first overall in Congressional Debate at both Westlake High School and Austin Liberal Arts and Sciences Academy tournaments.

TMI REPRESENTED AT HOBY LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Justin Khemalaap '24 and Bernice Gitiche '24 were nominated to represent TMI at the Hugh O'Brian Youth (HOBY) Texas Capital Area State Leadership seminar at the University of Texas at Austin. The annual seminar provides opportunities for leadership development, interactions with local community leaders, hands-on leadership activities and participation in a community service project.

MIDDLE SCHOOLER COMPETES INDIVIDUALLY AT MATHCOUNTS COMPETITION SERIES STATE QUALIFIER

Caroline Percival was the only individual "mathlete" competing without a team at the MATHCOUNTS Competition, held at St. Mary's University. Caroline was selected to compete in the live elimination round on stage, and did a fantastic job problem solving. She scored 14th overall, which qualified her to compete at the State MATHCOUNTS competition.

Annual giving supports the yearly operating budget for the school and bridges the gap between the true cost of delivering excellence in education at TMI and the cost of tuition. Annual giving helps us invest in campus infrastructure, professional development, and enhancements to our programs without running a deficit from school operations. To withstand drought conditions, some trees grow very deep and robust taproots to find a deeper water table. The most deep-seated taproot ever recorded was found on a wild fig tree in the Echo Caves of South Africa. It measured almost 400 feet deep.

At TMI, over the last 130 years, our roots have fortified us for sustained growth well into the future.



Donor Spotlight: Retired Teacher, Soccer Coach and Dorm Parent, Mario Rivela



Mr. Mario Rivela is one of TMI's most beloved retired teachers. Teaching wasn't the only hat Mr. Rivela wore at TMI; He also coached soccer, drove the bus, and was a dorm parent. We're grateful to have a legacy such as Mr. Rivela's as part of TMI's incredible history.





Mario Rivela was born in Italy. He moved to Missouri with his aunt and uncle and attended Northeast Missouri State Teachers College, where he received his degree. Rivela came to America to practice medicine, but he couldn't speak English. He knew Latin and decided he could be a teacher of Latin. In 1959, Rivela registered with a teaching agency and got teaching placements in Latin and Spanish. Mr. Rivela was eager to teach and got on with the Webb School in Tennessee. At Webb, he went to the president of the school and asked if he could teach for a year. He spent five years at Webb, then went to Lake Forest Academy for one year, and back to Webb for a few more years. He explained that he was a very strict teacher and pushed his students to perform. At Webb, his two Latin classes were 99% grade average,

After Webb, in 1967, Mr. Rivela came to TMI. He originally did not want to go to TMI, but his wife, Gladys Rivela, made him. Mr. Rivela was first hired as a dorm parent and teacher, but teaching was his favorite. He taught about five or six classes every year, and after class would run to change clothes and get to the soccer field.


with every class and all students.

One of his favorite TMI traditions is the family-style formal dinners. The community would come together for dinners pretty frequently. He also discussed the delicious meals at TMI, such as Sundays for filet mignon, potatoes, broccoli, and pecan pie. Mr. Rivela was a part of the moving crew as the supervisor, moving TMI from its old campus on Old Main to its current campus. He remembers staying in a motel across the street as the Senior dorm he would be staying in wasn't yet ready. Mr. Rivela saved the two big trees in what's known on our campus now as the Rivela Garden. He carried water from the apartment he lived in to the two big trees.

TMI was home for Mr. Rivela and his family. They had no relatives in San Antonio, so this became their home away from home. This inspires Mr. Rivela to keep giving back to TMI. He recalls many fond memories at TMI and continues to stay involved with the TMI community. The advice he has for current TMI students is to apply themselves as much as they can and to take advantage of the good teaching at TMI. Mr. Rivela elaborates that TMI has been very important to him and his family's lives, attributing that to his reason for why people should consider an estate gift to TMI. Along with that, he and his wife believe in education and studying, and enjoy the idea of leaving gifts for the kids and the school. Mario and Gladys Rivela are both excellent examples of TMI's core values and their legacy will continue to shine.
